SEPTEMBER 3, 2019

The Governing Body of the City of Sublette, Kansas met in regular session at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Lawrence Hoerman presiding and the following members of the City Council present: James Barber, Leon Birney, Tom Stoppel and Dylan Shotton. Also present were City Superintendent Daylen Elsey, Fire Chief Rusty Sherwood and City Clerk Jeannie Trigg. Sheriff Troy Briggs arrived at 7:34 p.m. Visitor was John Hall.

The minutes of the last regular were approved as distributed with a motion by Councilmember Shotton, seconded by Councilmember Birney. The motion carried 4-0.

Fire Chief Rusty Sherwood was present to give the monthly fire report. He and John Hall discussed with the Council a budget concerning the purchasing of a different City tanker firetruck. They discussed the status on the radios.

Sheriff Troy Briggs was present to give the monthly law enforcement report. He informed the Council on a sobriety check point that was at the four way stop. He discussed enforcing traffic issues.

Superintendent Elsey gave the monthly water report. He talked with the mastic products people. Street sealing is set for September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. He discussed T & T mowing longer in the season over the contract time of end of August. A motion was made by Councilmember Birney, seconded by Councilmember Shotton to allow T & T to mow through September. The motion carried 4-0. They reviewed maintenance applications for a maintenance worker. A motion was made by Councilmember Birney, seconded by Councilmember Shotton to hire Ben Martens. The motion carried 4-0.

City Clerk Trigg present to the Council bids from T & T Landscaping for a sprinkler system and dirt work and sod for the Big City Park. No action was taken.

Mayor Hoerman recommended that the Council adopt the 2019 editions published by the League of Kansas Municipalities for Standard Traffic and Uniform Public Offense Code for the Cities in Kansas with changes and exceptions to revise the ordinances. He presented Ordinance No. 439: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS ADOPTING THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR CITIES IN KANSAS" WHICH PROVIDES FOR TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, DEFINING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREFORE; AND THEN RE-ENACTING AND RETAINING OF CERTAIN PREVIOUSLY PASSED TRAFFIC ORDINANCES. A motion was made by Councilmember Barber, seconded by Councilmember Stoppel, to adopt Ordinance No. 439. The motion carried 4-0.

Hoerman presented Ordinance No. 440: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS ADOPTING “THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES”, AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AND REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS; AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS NOTED. A motion was made by Councilmember Birney, seconded by Councilmember Barber, to adopt Ordinance No. 440. The motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Hoerman discussed airport expenses.

A motion was made by Councilmember Birney, seconded by Councilmember Shotton to approve and allow payment of the bills as distributed. The motion carried 4-0.

Councilmember Barber made a motion to adjourn at 9:27 p.m., seconded by Councilmember Stoppel. The motion carried 4-0.
