ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE APPONTING AN ENFORCING OFFICER FOR THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS PURSUANT TO KANSAS STATUTES ANNOTATED 12-1750

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Sublette, Kansas that an appropriate and efficient process is established to address dangerous structures and abandoned property in the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. This ordinance is established for proper handling of unsafe or dangerous structures and abandoned property within the City of Sublette, Kansas.

SECTION 2. DESIGNATION OF ENFORCING OFFICER. The City of Sublette hereby designates the Sublette City Superintendent as the "Enforcing Officer" for the administration of Unsafe or dangerous structures and abandoned property as set out in K.S.A. 12-1750 *et seq.* The Enforcing Officer shall have all duties and authority as set out in the same.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official newspaper.
