A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS APPROVING THE SATANTA AREA ARTS COUNCIL, A NONPROFIT ENTITY, TO HOLD AN EVENT PROMOTING THE ARTS AND APPROVING THE SERVING OF COMPLIMENTARY ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR OR CERAL MALT BEVERAGES AT THE EVENT

WHEREAS, Satanta Area Arts Council's mission statement is to act as a coordinating, educational, and service organization to foster, promote, encourage, and increase the knowledge, appreciation, and practice of the arts in Haskell County and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the Satanta Area Arts Council is a nonprofit entity; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 41-104, complimentary alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages may be served at an event sponsored by a nonprofit organization promoting the arts so long as the event has been approved by the local governing body and the State of Kansas Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control has been notified of such an event at least 10 days in advance; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to approve the Satanta Area Arts Council event for the day of November 11, 2023 to be held at the American Legion Hall located at 216 S. Inman Street, Sublette, Kansas, and authorize the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor and/or cereal malt beverages.

THEREFORE, the governing body of the City of Sublette, Kansas, by this resolution, hereby authorizes the serving of complimentary alcoholic liquor and/or cereal malt beverages to members of the general public on the unlicensed premises located at 216 S. Inman Street, Sublette, Kansas on November 11, 2023 for an event promoting the arts, held by the Satanta Area Arts Council, a nonprofit entity, provided that proper notification has been provided at least 10 days prior to the event to the Kansas Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control
