The Governing Body of the City of Sublette, Kansas met in regular session at City Hall at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Jery Bailey presiding and the following members of the City Council present: Lawrence Hoerman, James Barber, Leon Birney, Tom Stoppel and Dylan Shotton. Also present were City Attorney Lynn Koehn, Sheriff Troy Briggs, City Superintendent Daylen Elsey and City Clerk Jeannie Trigg. William Guenther was the only visitor.

Mayor Bailey opened the meeting with a prayer.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were approved as distributed with a motion by Councilmember Barber, seconded by Councilmember Birney. The motion carried 5-0.

William Guenter, with 56 Tire Shop, was present to discuss a sewer hookup at 300 W. Lalande.

Sheriff Briggs gave the monthly law enforcement report for the City. He discussed doing and happenings within the City.

City Superintendent Elsey gave the monthly water report. He informed the Council that November 8th & 9th Kansas Rural Water Association will be conducting smoke testing of the sanitary sewer system. He discussed inspection of the water tower; the last inspection was April 8, 2014. It is recommended to do inspections every three years. A motion was made by Councilmember Barber, seconded by Councilmember Birney to have Inland Potable Services, Inc. inspect the water tower. The motion carried 5-0. He also discussed electrical work on the Christmas lights on Inman Street. Ryon Fisher gave a bid \$750.00 to do the work. A motion was made by Councilmember Hoerman, seconded by Councilmember Shotton to accept the bid from Ryon Fisher to do the electrical work. The motion carried 5-0.

He discussed putting the tin on the roof of the City shop.

A motion was made by Councilmember Hoerman, seconded by Councilmember Barber to approve and allow payment of the bills as distributed. The motion carried 5-0.

Councilmember Barber made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Birney. The motion carried 5-0.
