The Governing Body of the City of Sublette, Kansas met in Special Session at City Hall at 5:20 p.m., with Mayor Lawrence Hoerman presiding and the following members of the City Council present: Leon Birney, Tom Stoppel, Jason Vaughan, Cassie Davis and Denton Unruh. Also present were City Attorney Lynn Koehn, City Superintendent Daylen Eisey, City Clerk Shayla Makings, City Treasurer Becky Morris, and representatives of Lewis, Hooper & Dick accounting firm Theresa Dasenbrock, Kristin Sekavec and Trent Weber.


The purpose of the meeting was a budget work session for the 2023 budget and to present the 2021 audit results.

Kristin Sekavec, CPA from Lewis, Hooper & Dick, presented the Council with the results of the 2021 audit of the Statutory Basis Financial Statements of the City of Sublette. A motion was made by Councilmember Birney to accept the 2021 audit, seconded by Councilmember Unruh. The motion carried 5-0.

Theresa Dasenbrock, CPA from Lewis, Hooper & Dick, presented the proposed budget for 2023. The Council discussed the budget and the effect of mill levies. Councilmember Davis made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Vaughan to approve and accept the proposed budget for 2023 with the tax rate of 58.595 mills, each mill being \$10,076.13, to be published in The Garden City Telegram and to set the revenue neutral hearing for September 6, 2022 at 7:00pm and the budget hearing for September 6, 2022 at 7:10 p.m. at City Hall. The motion carried 5-0.

Councilmember Birney made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilmember Davis at 6:51pm. The motion carried 5-0.
