ORDINANCE NO. 452

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES", 48TH EDITION PUBLISHED IN 2021 AND REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 14-101, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Sublette, Kansas:

Section 1. That existing Section 14-101 of the Code of the City of Sublette, Kansas, is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

"INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Sublette, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", 48th Edition published in 2021, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, section, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified, or changed. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 452", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge, and all Administrative Departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient. The Standard Traffic Ordinance currently adopted by the City shall be amended or supplemented, as the case may be, by all other sections of this article regardless of whether such other sections were adopted before or after the current Standard Traffic Ordinance."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Haskell County Monitor and Chief*, the official city newspaper.
