CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS RESOLUTION NO. 160115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUBLETTE, KANSAS ADOPTING THE SOUTH-SOUTHWEST KANSAS (REGION D) MULTI-HAZARD, MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

NOW, on this 1^{st} day of June 2015, being a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Sublette, Kansas the following resolution is duly made:

WHEREAS, the City Council of Sublette, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of Sublette;

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from hazard occurrences;

WHEREAS, the United States government passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments;

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation grant programs;

WHEREAS, the City of Sublette fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA Region VII officials have reviewed the South-Southwest (Region D) Multi-Hazard, Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body;

WHEREAS, the City of Sublette desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the South-Southwest Kansas (Region D) Multi-Hazard, Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, adoption of this plan by the City of Sublette demonstrates the City's commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this plan; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this plan legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that City Council of the City of Sublette, Kansas, adopts the South-Southwest Kansas (Region D) Multi-Hazard, Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official Plan.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Sublette, Kansas will submit this resolution to the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA Region VII officials to enable the plan's final approval.
